The Arts by the Sea festival is an eight-day contemporary festival of combined arts that takes place in various indoor and outdoor locations around Bournemouth. The festival's mission is to deliver a programme of exceptional events, combining high-impact outdoor spectacles with world music, theatre shows, light art and digital installations.

Role:	Arts by the Sea Volunteer
Reporting to:	Senior Business Support Officer
Timeframe:	29 th September to 6 th October 2018 (with training and inductions in September)
Objectives:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To promote the festival by giving information to the public about locations, performances and prices. To encourage people to fill out a survey about the festival. To man the festival information points and with stewarding events and workshops during the festival.
Opportunities available:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Saturday 29th and Sunday 30th September, 11:30am to 11:00pm (4 hour shifts): give out information, collect data, encourage the audience to fill out our survey and ensure audience enjoy the festival. Volunteers may also be required to work with artists to steward performances. Saturday 29th September, 9:00 – 10:00pm: Stewards for performance "Herberts Dream". Saturday 6th October (evening): Stewards for closing parade.
Skills and qualifications/ requirements:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Over 16 (parent consent is required if you are under 18) A genuine desire to help the Arts by the Sea Festival reach its goals. Able to make your own travel arrangements to attend your volunteering opportunity (travel passes may be available). Listen to and follow instructions from staff within the remit of the volunteer role. Do your best to be reliable in regards to your hours and give us as much notice as possible if you cannot attend. Act and represent the Council in a suitable manner when wearing the Arts by the Sea festival uniform. Agree to work within Bournemouth Borough Council's values, policies and procedures, as outlined in our Volunteer Policy.

Shifts to be advised, subject to change and flexible depending on your requirements. You will be covered by Bournemouth Borough Council's insurance while in this role and when on site at the Arts by the Sea festival. You may be asked to wear uniform if working on site during the festival.

Meeting the team and induction:	You will be asked to come in and meet the festival team at the Town Hall Annexe and if appointed into this volunteer opportunity will be given an induction.
