## PHOTOGRAPHY

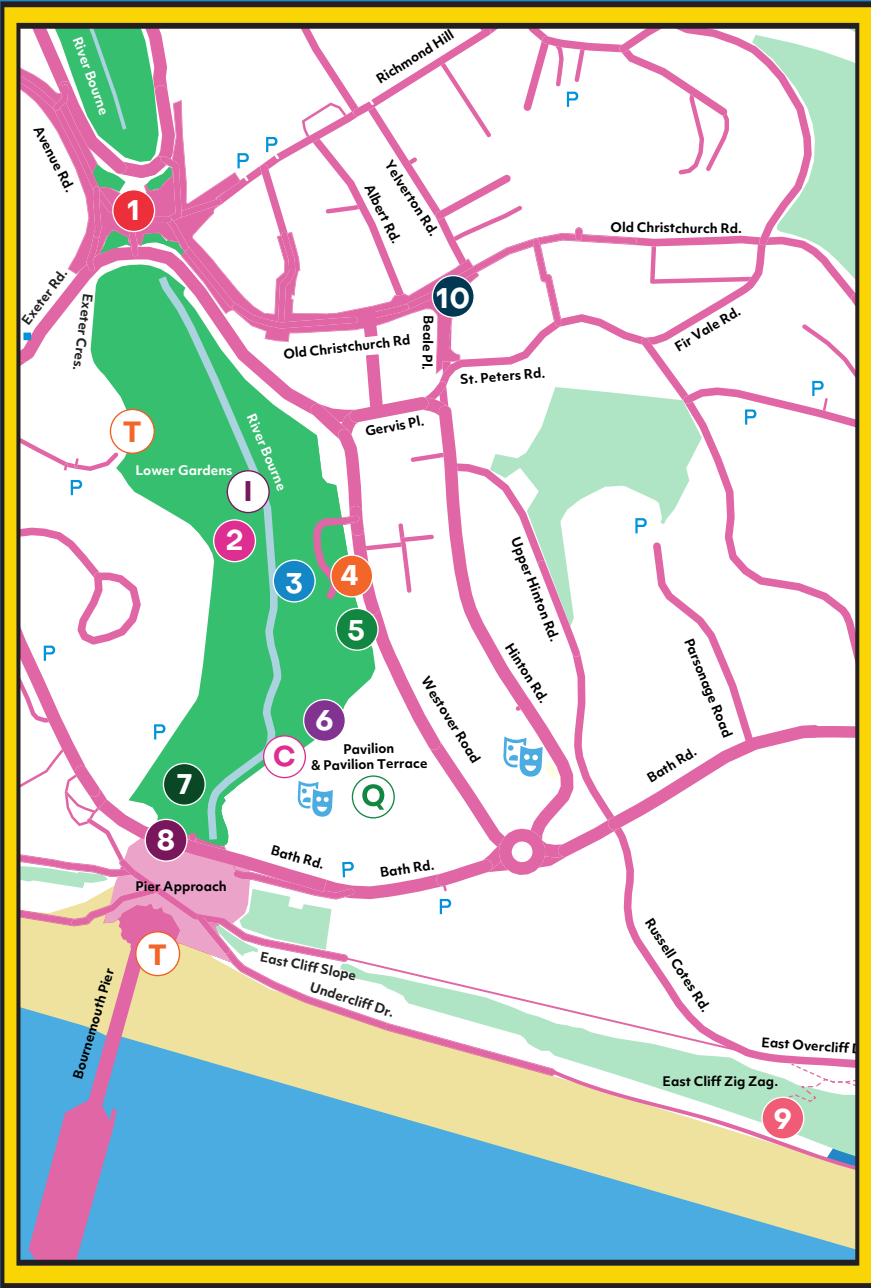

Our Associate Artist scheme invests in the development of local artists and under-represented art forms, providing a platform for rarely showcased art in the region.

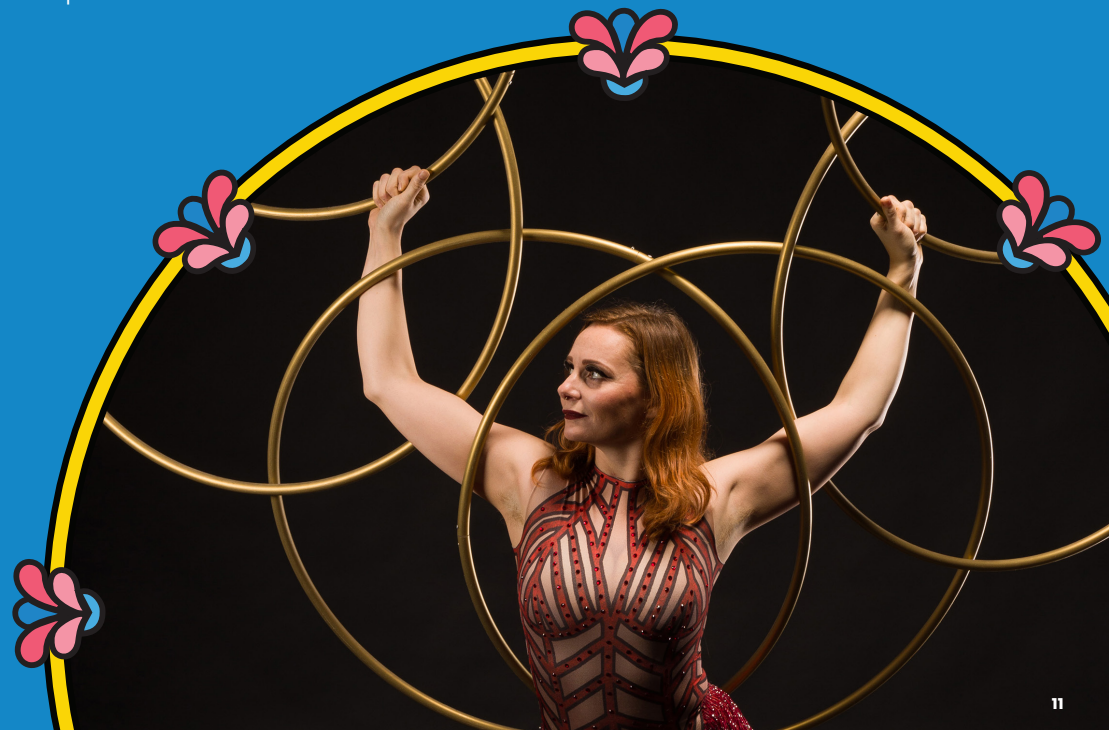

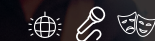

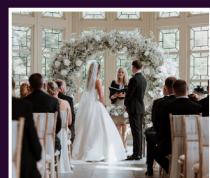
