

WHAT IS THE FRINGE?

Arts by the Sea Festival 2025 takes place over the weekend of 26–28 September.

The Fringe runs either side of the main festival, from 19 September to 5 October, bringing two full weeks of creative buzz across Bournemouth, Christchurch and Poole.

Arts by the Sea Fringe invites local venues to host performances, installations, workshops, theatre, and more – promoting them in collaboration with the Arts by the Sea Festival.

Already have something programmed during the Fringe period? No problem - existing events can be included too.

As an official Fringe venue, you'll receive:

Depending on your capacity, we've created a tiered fee system to keep things accessible:

- · Small venues (under 50 capacity): £50
- · Medium venues (50–150 capacity): £100
- · Large venues (150+ capacity): £150

One-time fee per venue, regardless of number of events. All fees go toward festival marketing, admin and coordination.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

We're excited to hear from you – but please check the Fringe criteria before applying. Events must align with the creative vision of **Arts by** the Sea.

- Events should include or promote the arts, such as: music, theatre, performance, comedy, dance, creativity, crafts, heritage or culture.
- Events can include performances, exhibitions, workshops, creative markets, and talks.

- We particularly welcome events that:
 - · Are inclusive, accessible, and celebrate diversity
 - Support emerging artists,
 local performers, and talent
 development
 - Have a strong link to sustainability

All events are **subject to approval** by the Arts by the Sea team.
